# GO!

**Before you start work:  
Check if it can be done safely!**

- 1** Do I understand the work instructions?
- 2** Has the work permit been discussed with me, including checks on safety measures?
- 3** Do I have access to approved tools and the right/sufficient resources?
- 4** Do I have the right PPE?
- 5** Is the work environment organised in such a way that the work can be done safely?
- 6** Can I think of at least 2 risks that I'm exposed to if I don't follow the instructions?
